Currency is money, that a country or region officially uses to buy goods and services. It can be in physical form like coins and bank notes or in digital form like bank balances, or digital currency. Usually a country's Central Bank issues currency. Here are some more information about currencies.

- World's most expensive currency is Kuwaiti Dinar (KWD).
- Australia was the first country to introduce polymer (plastic) bank notes.
- Canada has “Glow-in-the-Dark” money which glows under Ultraviolet light.
- The US Dollar is largely accepted around the world.
- The Swiss Franc notes are the most beautifully designed and secure banknotes in the world.
- The Indian Rupee symbol (₹) was designed by D. Udaya Kumar in 2010.
- All coins sink but Japan's 1 Yen Coin can float as it is made up of aluminium.
- The British Pound is the oldest currency still in use.
- Reserve Bank of India is India's Central Bank. It controls Indian monetary system and issues currency in India.
