Facts Related to Indian Mythology

- ★ Time is divided into **four yugas** :- **Satyuga**, **Treta**, **Dwapara** and **Kalyuga**.
- ★ **The Trinity** – **Lord Brahma** (the creator), **Lord Vishnu** (the preserver) and **Lord Shiva** (the destroyer) keep the balance of the universe.
- ★ **Four Vedas** – The **Rigveda**, **Yajurveda**, **Samaveda** and **Atharvaveda** are India's oldest sacred texts, containing hymns, prayers and wisdom. 
- ★ India's two great epics are : the **Ramayana** and the **Mahabharata**.
- ★ The Ramayan was written by sage **Valmiki**. 
- ★ The Mahabharat was narrated by sage **Vyasa** and written by **Lord Ganesha** with his tusk. 
- ★ Gayatri Mantra is one of the oldest hymns from the Rigveda.
